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Open Burning Requirement Information

The following information is a guideline for code requirements for open burning including but not limited to bonfires and fires to be used for horticultural purposes. Other requirements may apply depending on the specific jurisdiction (town, village, unincorporated areas). Information herein contained is not all-inclusive. Other requirements may apply.

1. No person shall kindle or maintain or authorize 5. The location for open burning shall not be less to be kindled or maintained any open burning than 50 feet from any structure and provisions unless conducted or approved in accordance with shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading to the adopted International Fire Code or other code within 50 feet of any structure. (Some exceptions as adopted by ordinance. apply). 2. A permit shall be obtained from the fire code 6.
