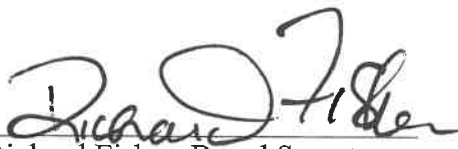
Closed Session
